

## THE LOWE-HILDEBRAND-LUBINSKY (LHL) SCHOLARSHIP FUND



Dr. Lowe devoted his career to the professions and higher education. He is a Fellow of ASHA and ISHA, and former President of the Illinois Association of Allied Health Professionals as well as a former President of the Arkansas Speech-Language-Hearing Association. He served GSU as both Department Chair and Dean of the College of Health Professions. Dr. Lowe arrived at GSU in 1972, with the task of establishing a department and curriculum for training speech-language pathologists.



He hired Mrs. Hildebrand to run the clinical practicum component in 1973, and Dr. Lubinsky, a dually-certified speech-language pathologist and audiologist, in 1974. Together the three grew the program and faculty, eventually achieving accreditation of the master's program in 1987.



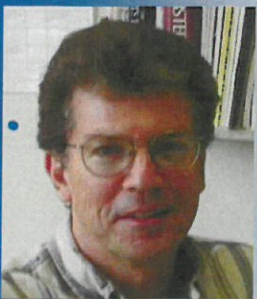
Dr. Lubinsky, now an ASHA Fellow, eventually served as department chair as well as Dean during his tenure at GSU. Since its inception, the CDIS department has been a thriving part of the GSU community, awarding over 1600 bachelor's and master's degrees in total.

Lowe, Hildebrand and Lubinsky were a part of every CDIS student's story until they retired – first Dr. Lowe, in 2000 (who later went on to establish graduate programs at two other universities), then Mrs. Hildebrand in 2004, followed by Dr. Lubinsky in 2007. Their legacy lives on in our unique, community-based practicum training system and newly re-accredited graduate curriculum.
