

Associate of Applied Science in Medical Office Administration to Bachelor of Health Administration

The following is presented as an articulation agreement between Harper College (Harper) and Governors State University (GSU) for the Health Administration degree program based on the current catalogs for both institutions. The student would receive an Associate in Applied Science (AAS) degree from Harper and a Bachelors of Health Administration (BHA) degree from GSU. **The BHA degree is offered at Triton College. Applicants must have obtained a minimum of 2.50 GPA for the last 60 hours.**
