

**Brian D. Mitchell, Chair**

Brian Mitchell has served as the Village Administrator for the Village of Matteson since 2010. As the Chief Administrative Officer he acts as liaison for the Village of Matteson and its Board of Trustees with residents, other municipalities, government agencies and organizations. Mitchell started his tenure with the Village of Matteson in 2008 as Director of Human Resources, quickly being promoted to Deputy Village Administrator in 2009 and to his current position the following year. Prior to his position with the Village of Matteson, Mitchell held leadership positions in the Cook County Bureau of Human Resources. He also worked at PSI Services, Incorporated for seven years, working extensively with the Department of Children and Family Services leading efforts in directing, coordinating and evaluating the performance of team coordinators and licensing representatives.

Mitchell was appointed to the Governors State University Board of Trustees by Governor Pat Quinn in October 2011. In October 2012 he was elected by his peers to serve as Vice Chair.

Mitchell holds a Master's Degree in Human Services and Administration from Spertus College of Jewish Studies, and a Bachelor's Degree in Sociology and Criminology from Northern Illinois University. He is a member of Kappa Alpha Psi, Fraternity, Inc.
