

Teacher Training on the Danielson Observable Components

Governors State University (GSU) is offering two duplicate three-day workshops for teachers on the eight observable components of the Danielson Framework. Each three-day workshop is worth 10 CPDUs.

Workshop I will be on the GSU campus, 1 University Parkway, University Park, IL 60484 on Thursday, February 27, Thursday, March 6, and Thursday, March 13, from 4:15 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. The fee is \$100. Sessions will be held in the Hall of Honors.

Workshop II will be at the Eisenhower Cooperative Administrative Center, 5318 West 135th Street, Crestwood, IL 60445 on Tuesday, April 1, Tuesday, April 8, and Tuesday, April 15, from 4:15 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. The fee is \$100.

What can you expect?

- The instructor will use the Teachscape training materials.
- Session 1 will be an in-depth analysis of each of the 8 observable components.
- Sessions 2 and 3 will be an analysis of how the 8 observable components are rated.
- An outline of teaching behaviors for each rating level will be developed.

Why should you take this workshop?

- It will improve your teaching.
- It will make you more aware of the teaching behaviors your principal is evaluating.
- It will help fulfill your CPDU requirement.
- It will provide strategies if you need to pass the ISBE teacher evaluation assessment.

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
