

THE UNIVERSITY HONORS PROGRAM  
FINAL PROJECT AGREEMENT

A major component of The University Honors Program is that students complete a final project for the program. The final project, which is completed under the supervision of a faculty mentor, should be relevant to the individual student's field of study and represent the transition from their undergraduate work to a graduate or professional orientation. While prior work may be used as a foundation for this project, it is recommended that the project itself should take that work to the next level of academic rigor and excellence. While this is a general guideline, the purpose of this component is to allow students to do advanced studies, above and beyond their normal course work, so as to provide them with greater depth within their academic programs.

Early in the term the sponsor/mentor and the honors student should meet to determine the requirements for the final project. Please note, this agreement is based solely on the academic judgment of the sponsor/mentor. This agreement is simply a statement of expectations. The honors student will hold the signed agreement until the acceptance of the final project at which time the sponsor/mentor will sign it at the appropriate place signifying that the student has completed this requirement.
