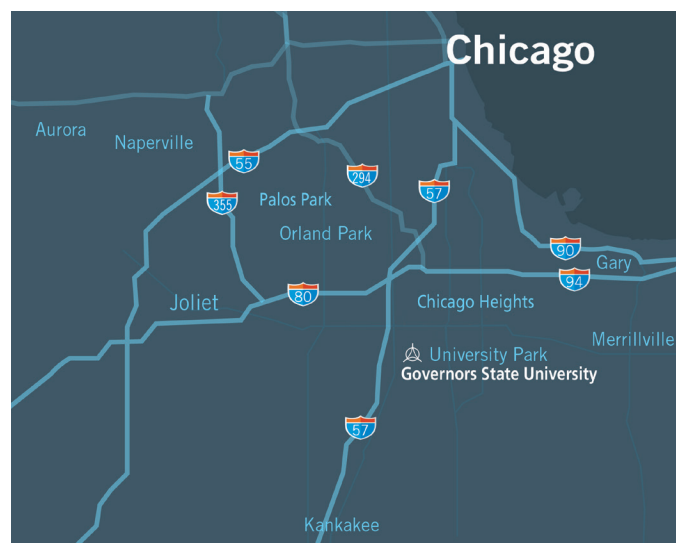
ABOUT GSU
