Services offered:

- **Required immunizations** for full compliance with the College Student Immunization Act [110 ILCS 20]
- Sexually Transmitted Disease (STD)/Sexually Transmitted Infection (STI) screenings
- Women's Health Screenings
- Basic Physicals (Sports, Program, Work)
- Minor Illnesses: Coughs, Colds, Nausea, Earaches, Sinus Infections, Fevers, Urinary Tract Infections
- Minor Injuries: Sprains/Strains
- Skin Conditions: Rashes, Bites

Services are provided by appointment only. Same day appointments available schedule permitting. No walk-ins allowed.

Immunization Quick Checklist

For all students

- Proof of **ONE** Tdap (tetanus, diphtheria and pertussis) vaccination within the **past 10 years**
- Proof of **TWO** prior tetanus vaccines (DTP, DTap, DT, Td or Tdap)
 - **IF YOU CAN'T PROVIDE PROOF** of two prior tetanus vaccines, a **MEDICAL NOTE** from a licensed health care provider stating “No other record of tetanus available” is **REQUIRED**
- Proof of MMR (measles, mumps and rubella) – **TWO** doses of vaccination with the **first dose** being **AFTER** your 1st birthday and the second dose **AT LEAST** 4 weeks after **OR**
 - **IF YOU CAN'T PROVIDE PROOF OF TWO MMR VACCINES** – a **blood draw** is required for measles, mumps and rubella to **PROVE IMMUNITY**
 - If your results show you are **NOT** immune, two vaccine doses **MUST** be given:
 - Second dose **must** be given **AT LEAST** 4 weeks after the first dose
- Students born **before January 1, 1957** – Proof of MMR is **NOT** needed

For students age 21 and younger (ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENT)

- Proof of one meningitis vaccination (meningococcal conjugate **ACWY**) given **AFTER** the age of 16
 - Menveo®
 - Menactra®
 - MenQuadfi®

For international students (ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENT)

- TB (tuberculosis testing done within the U.S. in the past **12 months**)
 - PPD skin test **OR** QuantiFERON-TB Gold blood draw
 - Chest X-ray is required for **ALL** positive or equivocal TB test results
- Please remember that all documents require a provider signature **AND** an office stamp
