This project grew from a need found by several school district partners—high-needs districts were hindered by local and national teacher shortages (Nguyen et al., 2022) and asked how we could support their staffing needs. These partners wanted to connect with students and market the benefits of working in high needs schools (Engel & Cannata, 2015). Complementary to this request, our student teachers needed more support for their employment searches. During each student teaching semester, our LPP faculty taught a job search seminar to our pre-service educators. This presentation included advice on finding positions, preparing resumes, and answering interview questions. However, faculty perceived that candidates needed more direct practice responding to interview questions. Therefore, we invited six high-needs partner districts to take part in a mock job fair. Each district sent one or more administrators to help our candidates practice their interview skills using compact interviews (Stronge & Hindman, 2006). In return, our student teachers shared their resume with each district during the interviews. By exposing our candidates to high-needs schools, we hoped our candidates would be more likely to seek employment opportunities there (Cannata, 2010; Engel & Cannata, 2015). Principal leadership faculty were critical with outreach to partners and our knowledge of personnel processes in local school districts. In addition, having interviewed and hired hundreds of educators, our background supplied insightful advice to build candidates' job search capacity. The event was extraordinarily successful, with all six districts affirming their participation in future events.
