



Associate in Arts to Bachelor of Health Science in Communication Disorders

The following is presented as an articulation agreement between Moraine Valley Community College (MVCC) and Governors State University (GSU) for the Communication Disorders degree program based on the current catalogs of both schools. The student would receive an Associate in Arts (AA) degree from MVCC and a Bachelors of Health Science (BHS) degree in Communication Disorders from GSU. **Students are required to have 2.75 GPA for admission to the GSU Communication Disorders program.**

- PSY 215 - Educational Psychology (3) (recommended)
