



Associate in Applied Science in Criminal Justice to Bachelor of Arts in Criminal Justice

The following is presented as an articulation agreement between Moraine Valley Community College (MVCC) and Governors State University (GSU) for the Criminal Justice degree program based on the current catalog from MVCC and GSU. The student would receive an Associate in Applied Science (AAS) in Criminal Justice degree from MVCC and a Bachelors of Arts (BA) degree in Criminal Justice from GSU.
