



## Associate in Applied Science to Bachelor of Arts in Criminal Justice

The following is presented as an articulation agreement between South Suburban College (SSC) and Governors State University (GSU) for the Criminal Justice degree program based on the current catalogs of both schools. The student would complete an Associate in Applied Science (AAS) from SSC and a Bachelors of Arts (BA) degree in Criminal Justice from GSU.
