

Transfer Guide

Argosy University to Bachelor of Arts in Psychology

The following is presented as an articulation agreement between Argosy University (AU) and Governors State University (GSU) for Psychology degree program based on the current catalogs of both schools. The student would receive a Bachelor of Arts (BA) degree in Psychology from GSU. All credit hours are shown in semester hours.

I. TRANSFERABLE GENERAL EDUCATION (37 Hours)

General education courses not completed at AU can be completed at GSU.

Communications (9 hours)

- ENG 101 - Composition I (Meets ENGL 1000) (3)
- ENG 102 - Composition II (Meets ENGL 1010) (3)
- COM 114 - Public Speaking (Meets COMS 1160) (3)

Humanities and Fine Arts (9 hours)

Fine Arts (3) -

Course(s) to be completed at GSU; no equivalent courses AU.

Humanities Course (3) -

Select from the following courses: HUM 110, HUM 200, HUM 401, HUM 440, PHI 101, PHI 301

Additional Fine Arts or Humanities Course (3)

Mathematics (3 hours)

MAT 112 or MATH 210 or PSY 210 - Statistics (3) (Meets MATH 2100)

Physical and Life Sciences (7 hours)

Life Sciences (3-4) -

Select from the following courses: BIO 110, BIO 115, BIO 120, SCI 201/202, SCI 215/216

Physical Science (3-4) -

Select from the following courses: SCI 201/202, SCI 215/216

Social and Behavioral Sciences (9 hours)

Students must complete three social and behavioral sciences courses from at least two separate disciplines.

PSY 101 - General Psychology (3) (Meets PSYC 1101)

PSY 310 - Social Psychology (3) (Meets PSYC 2345)

Select from the following courses: ECO 201, ECO202, POL 110, SOC 110, SOC 111, SOC 416 (6)

- PSYC 2150 - Introduction to Research Methods (3) (Met by AU PSY 302)
- PSYC 2201 - Life-Span Development Psychology (3) (Met by AU PSY 316)
- PSYC 2410 - Personality Theories (3) (Met by AU PSY 362)
- PSYC 3099 - Ethics in Psychology (3) (Met by AU PSY 430)
- PSYC 3150 - Psychology Statistics (3)
- PSYC 3430 - Abnormal Psychology (3) (Met by AU PSY 381)
- PSYC 4950 - Psychological Issues and Social Values (3)

Cognitive/Behavioral Psychology: (select **one** of the following*)

- PSYC 3520 - Cognitive Psychology (3) (Met by AU PSY 363)
- PSYC 3524 - Principles of Learning and Behavior (3) (Met by PSY 383)

Biological Psychology: (select **one** of the following*)

- PSYC 3675 - Biopsychology (3) (Met by AU PSY 350)
- PSYC 3680 - Introduction to Neuropsychology (3)

(*If both are taken, one can be used towards the Psychology Electives)

III. Psychology Concentration (0-15 Hours)

(Adding a concentration is optional)

Forensic Psychology (15)

Mindfulness Studies (10)

Pre-Clinical Concentration (12)

IV. Psychology Electives (6-12 Hours)

A minimum of 6 hours must be at the 3000-4000 level.

(See GSU catalog and Argosy equate list for courses that meet the Psychology Electives and credits required for individual concentration options.)

V. ELECTIVES (26-47 Hours)

Elective courses can be completed at either AU or GSU. Electives can also be a combination of AU and GSU courses. A minimum of 9-27 hours must be at the 3000-4000 level. (Amounts will vary based on concentration if selected and psychology electives completed.)

Minimum Required for the BA in Psychology: 120 Hours
