Associate of Applied Science to Bachelor of Arts in Business and Applied Science

The following is presented as an articulation agreement between Kaskaskia College (KC) and Governors State University (GSU) for the Business and Applied Science degree program based on the catalogs of both schools. The student would receive an Associate of Applied Science (AAS) degree from KC and a Bachelors of Arts (BA) degree in Business and Applied Science from GSU.
