

## Associate in Applied Science in Medical Lab Technology to Bachelor in Health Administration

The following is presented as an articulation agreement between Kankakee Community College (KCC) and Governors State University (GSU) for the Health Administration degree program based on the current catalogs of both schools. The student would receive an Associate in Applied Science (AAS) in Medical Laboratory Technology degree from KCC and a Bachelors of Health Administration (BHA) degree at GSU. **Students are required to have a minimum GPA of 2.50 for admission to the program.**
