

# Transfer Guide



## Associate of Applied Science in Nursing to Bachelor of Science in Nursing

The following is presented as an articulation agreement between Kankakee Community College (KCC) and Governors State University (GSU) for the Community Health degree program based on the current catalogs of both schools. The student would receive an Associate of Applied Science (AAS) degree in Nursing from KCC and a Bachelors of Science (BSN) degree in Nursing from GSU. **Students are required to have a minimum GPA of 2.0 for admission to the program. The BSN degree is offered at GSU completely online.**

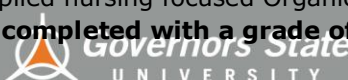
### REQUIRED A.A.S. DEGREE PROGRAM AND GENERAL EDUCATION TOTAL: 85 Hours

\*\*30 semester credit hours of lower division Nursing courses will be accepted for transfer towards the BSN; however 41 semester credit hours are required for the AAS in Nursing. No course work will need to be repeated at GSU.

<sup>^</sup>GSU CHEM 1143/1144 Chem II or CHEM 1113/1114 Intro-Organic & Bio Chem w/Lab can be completed in place of KCC CHEM 1624. CHEM 1113/1114 is an applied nursing focused Organic Chemistry.
