

Associate of Arts to Bachelor of Arts in Economics

The following is presented as an articulation agreement between Prairie State College (PSC) and Governors State University (GSU) for the Economics degree program based on the current catalogs of both schools. The student would receive an Associate in Arts (AA) degree from PSC and a Bachelors of Arts (BA) degree in Economics from GSU.
