

Associate of Arts to Bachelor of Arts in Anthropology and Sociology

The following is presented as an articulation agreement between Prairie State College (PSC) and Governors State University (GSU) for the Anthropology and Sociology degree program based on the current catalogs of both schools. The student would receive an Associate of Art (AA) degree from PSC and a Bachelors of Arts (BA) degree in Anthropology and Sociology from GSU.

I. TRANSFERABLE GENERAL EDUCATION CORE (37-39 Hours)

Area A: Communications (9 hours)

- ENG 101 - Composition I (3)
 - ENG 102 - Composition II (3)
 - COMM 101 - Principles of Communication (3)
- *Must have a C or better in ENG 101 & 102 to receive credit for the degree.*

Area B: Humanities and Fine Arts (9 hours)

- Humanities Course (3)*
- Fine Arts Course (3)*
- Humanities/Fine Arts Course (3)*

Area C: Mathematics (3-4 hours)

- (Either BUS 240 or MATH 115 OR 153 will meet MATH 2100 at GSU.)
- BUS 240 - Elementary Statistics (4) **OR**
 - MATH 115 - General Education Statistics (3) **OR**
 - MATH 153 - Probability and Statistics (4)

Area D: Physical and Life Sciences (7-8 hours)

- Select one life science course and one physical science course. Once course must have a lab.
- Life Science Course (3-4)
 - Physical Science Course (3-4)

Area E: Social and Behavioral Sciences (9 hours)

- ANTHR 222 - Intro to Cultural & Social Anthropology (Meets ANTH 1100)
- SOCIO 101 - Intro to Sociology (3) (Meets SOC 1100)
- SOCIO 215 - Sex, Gender and Power (3) (recommended; meet ANSO 2100 as GSU Selective)

II. ELECTIVES (23-24 Hours)

GSU's Anthropology and Sociology program suggests classes in any of the social sciences.

- SOCIO 210 - Marriage and the Family (recommended)
- SOCIO 220 - Race Relations: A Multicultural Perspective (recommended)
