

## **Associate of Applied Science in Automotive Technology to Bachelor of Arts in Interdisciplinary Studies Program**

The following is presented as an articulation agreement between Waubonsee Community College (WCC) and Governors State University (GSU) for the Interdisciplinary Studies degree program based on the current catalogs of both schools. The student would receive an Associate in Applied Science (AAS) degree in Automotive Technology from WCC and a Bachelors of Arts (BA) in Interdisciplinary Studies degree from GSU.
