

## Associate of Applied Science Occupational Programs to Business and Applied Science Program

The following is presented as an articulation agreement between Prairie State College (PSC) and Governors State University (GSU) for the Business and Applied Science degree program based on the catalog catalogs of both schools. The student would receive an Associate of Applied Science (AAS) degree from PSC and a Bachelors of Arts (BA) degree in Business and Applied Science from GSU.
