

## **Hour House -Cumberland County ROSC Council Meeting Minutes May 16th, 2022**

### **Membership Sharing:**

**Kristin Davis:** Provided insight on Prevention finishing their curriculum for the local schools.

**Celebrate Recovery:** Shared participation is very active, please share meeting information on social media.

**Karen:** Shared that the ROSC is hiring for a ROSC Coordinator and Recovery Navigator for Cumberland and Clark County. Karen put emphasis on the idea that these candidates are preferred to live in the community and requested the members to help share the word to help in the application process. Karen shared that she would have conversations with the perspective candidates and help in the application process.

**Cindy:** Introduced Donnelle Darling with the CCHD. Donnelle will plan to attend the ROSC meetings for/with Cindy.

### **Continuation of meeting with strategic goals discussion:**

**Membership involvement:** Karen asked who are we missing at the table and how can we further engage the community? Members shared several potential individuals who would be actively involved. Members delegated who would contact the individuals.

Members shared that they will continue to engage local community members and stakeholders.

**Safe Passage:** Karen has spoken with the safe passage group from Taylorville and will set up a meeting with the city police, county sheriff, and state attorney to have a discussion on what safe passage looks like and how it can be implemented in Cumberland County. Members provided support to the initial conversation and would like to receive updates.

**Telehealth Counseling:** Members followed up on the telehealth counseling services at the Court House, Karen said she would follow up with the appropriate contacts to receive status of this project.

### **Community events/Anti-Stigma/Education**

Karen reminded ROSC members that August 31<sup>st</sup> is National Overdose Awareness day; Karen explained to the members that they could host a candle light vigil to remember those who have lost their lives. Members suggested having a small group in each town due to lack of transportation. Karen encouraged the members to volunteer as the “host” if each town would like to participate.

Karen: Reminded the members that the articles are drawing to an end—she encouraged members to actively volunteer to help publish articles.

Members: suggested doing a Narcan training. Cindy Hanley with the Health Department volunteered to conduct a training. The training will be hosted on July 11<sup>th</sup> at 6 PM- the training will take place at First Neighbor Bank. Karen is creating flyers to engage the community.
