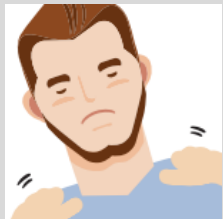
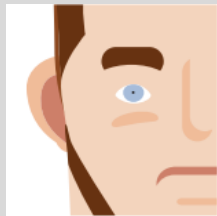


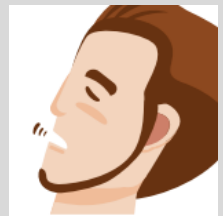

Pin-Point Pupils

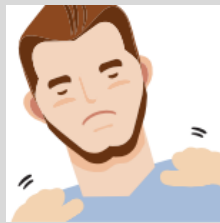


Slow or Shallow Breathing/Making Gurgle Sounds

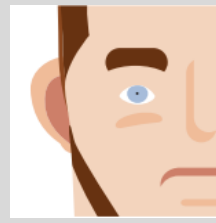


Fingernails/Lips Turning Blue/Gray; Face Clammy or Pale

Risk Factors for Opioid Overdose

Using Opioids for Pain Management
IV Drug Use

Abstained for a Period of Time
(Detox or Incarceration)

Non-Medical Use of Opioids
Using Two or More Drugs
Recent Overdose

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Suspect an Overdose is Occurring?

Step 1	Check for signs of an overdose
Step 2	Call for help (Dial 911)
Step 3	Support the person's breathing and pulse as needed
Step 4	Monitor their response and place them on their side
Step 5	If no response after 2-3 minutes, administer another dose of naloxone (NARCAN)
