

The ROSC Council is a coalition of community stakeholders and interested parties that meet regularly with an intention to identify current community resources or providers for recovery adjacent services, and to identify gaps in the continuum of care. The ROSC seeks to coordinate providers and services to help prevent service duplication and to utilize all our community providers and resources to the maximum benefit of people seeking recovery from SUD. Ideally, the group collaboration will evolve into a standing and sustainable organization that provides support and services for people in addiction and behavioral health recovery. In the case of the Sauk Valley, we already have such an entity in SVVOR. In our case, the ROSC can assist SVVOR in focusing their efforts as well as helping new groups and organizations develop and grow. The ROSC Council is open to all community organizations including the legal, educational, spiritual and recreational, law enforcement and health care systems. Along with the recovery community organization, the ROSC Council will encourage community partnerships and collaborations and work to reduce stigma. The ROSC Councils seek to be inclusive, equitable and diverse at its core and focuses on helping all people become a part of, rather than apart from their respective communities and establish greater hope and future for all.
