

Purpose

- Are willing to work collaboratively with others to achieve the goals of the ROSC Council.
- ROSC Council members would have signed MOU's.

All council members are expected to participate actively in council meetings and activities and to be committed to the mission and vision of the ROSC Council. Members will assist in identifying strengths and weaknesses in our community and will assist with strategic planning and developing the council action plan.

Recruitment

The ROSC Council will recruit members through the distribution of brochures, social media, presentations, and community discussions. It will also be every member of the ROSC Council's responsibility to recruit by word of mouth. The goal for our ROSC Council is to be inclusive rather than exclusive.
