Serena mentioned upcoming recovery event at Hebrewz Coffeehouse in Jonesboro on December 5<sup>th</sup>. Chrystal mentioned Southern Illinois Drug Awareness Conference to be held March 13<sup>th</sup> & 14<sup>th</sup> at SIUC, mentioned the conference is seeking speakers – asked if Tor (Neal) & Holly (Windhorst) could collaborate on a presentation about the “Too Good for Drugs” curriculum which Arrowleaf and MCDAC both utilize in Johnson and Massac Counties (respectively). John thanked everyone for their attendance and closed meeting.
