 - A. **Education & Prevention**- Heather Creasy-Chairperson:
 - Illinois Youth Survey update: As of 12/13/23, we still have just 4 schools signed up: Bartelso Elementary, Willow Grove Elementary, Carlyle High School and Germantown Elementary. For the data to count, we need more schools to sign up! We will try reaching out to the Health Dept. to see if they can help us get schools involved in the IYS. Too Good for Drugs and other evidence-based prevention programs will be used in Clinton County schools.
 - Telligen joined our meeting and Mary Ann advised they have many online education programs to expand our growth and strategic planning for the community.

 - B. **Law Enforcement**- Ken Sterner-Chairperson: no report/not present.
 - C. **Treatment & Recovery**- Cara Loddeke/Alicia Moesner- Co-Chairpersons:
 - We will be enhancing the Illinois Learning Collaborative outreach training. Nellie will reach law enforcement and other officials with the information to improve MAR and *988 services. We need support from our EMS and services as well as education for law enforcement staff.

 - We need to spend down the ROSC grant budget. Should be spending 25% each quarter. Plan to order supplies for Emotions Anonymous and SMART Recovery support groups and more stipend cards for individuals in recovery attending or helping with our meetings and activities.
