They are working to open more space.</p> <p>Crisis stabilization unit is for 3-7 days</p> <p>Child &amp; adult psychiatry services are available</p> <p>Assertive care treatment is available for individuals living in or near Carbondale</p> <p>Home for developmentally disabled individuals</p> <p>SUD campaign is currently underway that includes billboards, wrapped busses and other marketing.
