


INITIAL GAP ANALYSIS

- Lack of Recovery Homes, Half-Way Houses, and Transition Living Facilities: There is a significant absence of supportive housing options for individuals in recovery, hindering their transition to independent living.
- Insufficient Domestic Violence and Abused Women and Children Shelters: The absence of shelters leaves vulnerable populations without safe havens and support services.
- Limited Homeless Shelters and Food Banks: The scarcity of these resources exacerbates homelessness and food insecurity within the community.
- **Shortage** of Mental Health Refuges: With few mental health facilities available, individuals facing mental health challenges lack access to necessary care and support.
