

## May 16, 2024 ROSC Council Minutes:

Meeting was called to order by ROSC Coordinator Tia Schum at 3pm on May 16, 2024 at The Piatt County Mental Health Center.

**Communication Plan** – Tia discussed the Bement support group. The group has grown to 10! Tia explained that she is able to sit back and observe as the group does their meeting. Tia discussed the Suboxone clinic as well and the continued partnership Kirby Medical Group and The Center have.

Tony shared an update from last month's meeting that stated minors are allowed to purchase nonalcoholic drinks under the 0.05% BAAC level. This brought forth the question, does the ROSC move forward and push for an ordinance to make this a finable infraction.

Tia discussed upcoming volunteer opportunities in the community. Tia explained that she will need volunteers for these events in the case that her son(s) have football games.

**This Month's Activities** – Tia discussed the success of the expert panel discussion as well as ways to improve. Tia shared that from this expert panel, a phone call was received in regards to questions about services after release from DOC.

**Deliverables:** There were no guest speaker this month. The council reviewed where everyone sat in the ROSC sectors. It was discovered that there are a couple CIA's that need signed/changed. There is also a few changes that need to be made in regards to where a few folks sit.

Tia and the council also discussed the budget cut and guidelines sent out from the state. Tia, Maggie, and Tony will be traveling to GSU Monday evening for an all-day in-person meeting with all ROSCs in the state of Illinois. Tia is hoping to get clarity on a few things. It is stated in the guidelines that events will not be paid for if they are not following the 3 year strategic plan set forth by the ROSC council. The Piatt County 3 year plan does state that one of the short term goals is to create more sober recreation for the recovery community. Tia is hopeful there will be some clarity. In the event that events such as the paint party, murder mystery, etc. Will NOT be covered under the grant, ideas of raising money were shared by all in attendance. Such ideas included, trivia night, auctions, donations from Lions Club, Rotary, and partnerships were discussed. A few members asked about donating to the ROSC for these events as well.
