 - Illinois Youth Survey update: As of 5/13/24, we have the 10 schools signed up: Aviston Elementary, Bartelso Elementary, Carlyle High School, Central High School, Germantown Elementary*, Mater Dei High School**, North Wamac Grade School, and Wesclin HS*, Wesclin Jr. High, Willow Grove Elementary. Centralia High School and Centralia Jr. High* also signed up in Marion County (serves students from Clinton Cty. Side) completed the IYS. *surveying but not completed? **registered but not taken? All non-asterisked schools have completed the survey and a report was sent.

 - B. <u>Law Enforcement</u>- Ken Sterner-Chairperson: seized narcotics in Clinton County for the 1st quarter of 2024 for your awareness. This information comes from NIBRS where 52% of law enforcement reported in 2022. This number continues to increase annually.

The top 3 narcotics seized in Clinton County are as follows:

- Amphetamines/Methamphetamines 170 grams
- Marijuana 60 grams
- Other Stimulants 48 grams

 - Budget update: \$2171.60 balance. Nellie was reimbursed \$1129.00 for expenses the ROSC grant could not cover. Reimbursement form turned into 708 Mental Health Board for Celebrate Life and Red Ribbon Week support funds. Awaiting their check.
- F. Marketing Chairperson-Open:
 - Celebrate Life-Recovery (from Hurts, Habits, & Hang-Ups) planning: date is September 22nd. Need volunteers.
