### **Standing Coalition Business:**

• Minutes from the September meeting were approved unanimously with a motion made by Kindra York. Kat Houghton seconded the motion.

## **New and Standing Coalition Reports:**

- *Chris Dennis* presented a slideshow recapping local events held for Recovery Month. Agencies hosted recovery walks, picnics, and various events to show their support to those in recovery.
- Guest speaker, Jessie Blanchard (Jessie B) from Never Use Alone, joined via zoom to share information about the services she provides as the Educational Director of Never Use Alone, an Overdose Detection and Response Program. Never Use Alone is a tollfree, 24 hour harm reduction hotline where peer specialists stay on the phone while participants use drugs. The caller lets the peer specialist know where they are calling from, what they are using, and how they are using. They will then stay on the line until the specialist is assured the caller is no longer at risk of overdose. To date, *Never Use* Alone has fielded approximately 30,000 calls and has been responsible for over 100 overdose reversals since their inception in 2019. They are presently available to callers in both the US and Canada. Specialist Jessie B spoke on what drives her to do this line of work, which she describes as a labor of love. She was recently featured on the podcast, "This American Life" where she is spotlighted receiving a call and walking the caller safely through their drug use. While on the meeting, she answered many attendees' questions and touched many with her compassionate, genuine approach to harm reduction.
