Sangamon County ROSC

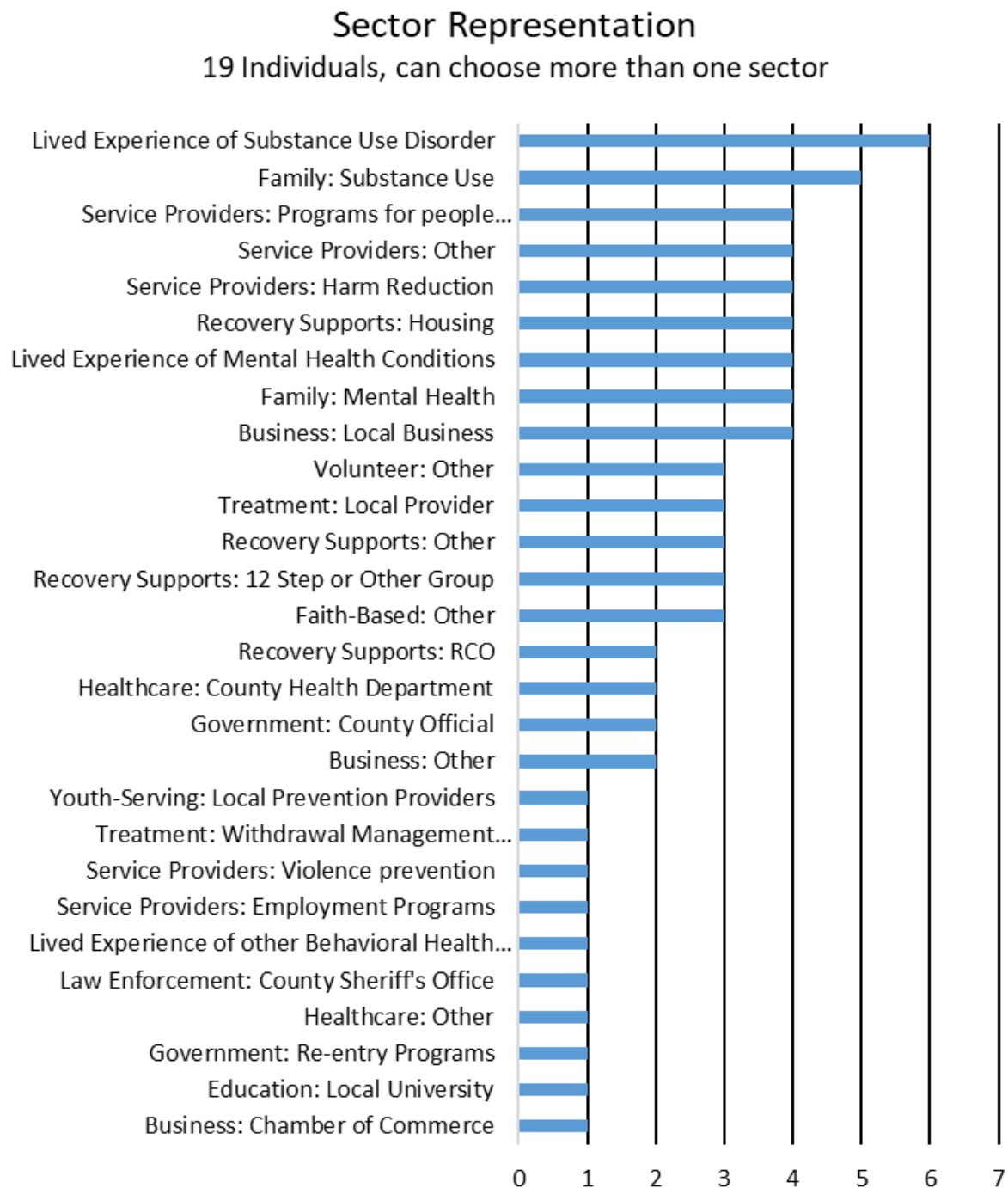
Vision:

- Services and supports are continuous, cohesive across different phases of care and are coordinated across agencies involved in their delivery
- Support of recovery is a community responsibility and value
- There is inherent flexibility in the system so it can responsive to different pathways to recovery
- Measuring quality and outcomes is a system priority
