- A compound has been discovered that increases the potency and duration of action of naloxone, a drug used to reverse the effects of opioid overdoses — possibly opening up another way to save lives. Compound 378.

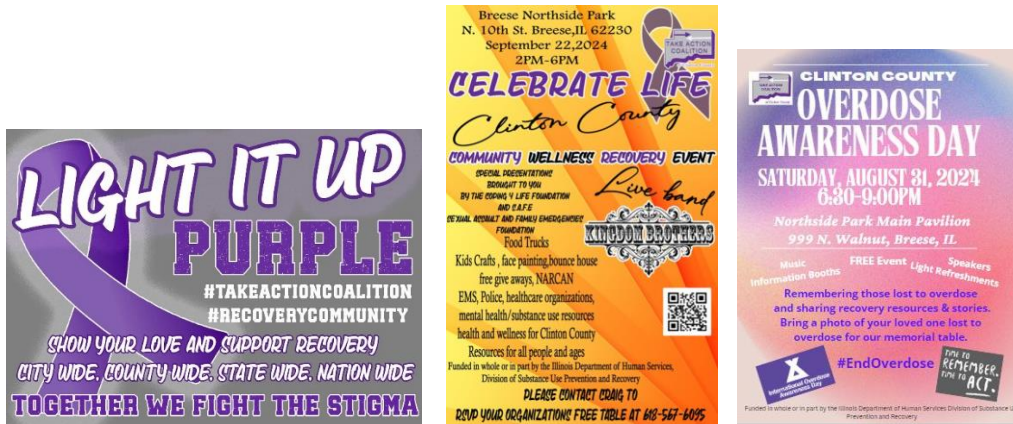
E. Finance- Deb Loddeke-Chairperson:
