Agenda Item: Introductions and Updates

Overview: The subcommittee finalized plans for the Candlelight Vigil and continued planning for the recovery picnic and discussed social media posts in honor of recovery month.

Vigil: The Vigil will be held on Friday, August 30th from 7 p.m. to 8 p.m. at The Greenup Municipal Building pavilion. Bo S. will be our speaker. Sara will provide bottles of water for the event if needed. We will have a table set up with pictures of the individuals we are honoring. Narcan and other resources will be available, as well as Narcan training upon request. The event will begin with our speaker, the list of names will be read followed by a prayer and the lighting of candles. Those in attendance will have the opportunity to speak about their loved ones.

Recovery Picnic: The picnic will be on September 7th from 11 a.m. to 2 p.m. at the Casey Fairview Park. Pulled pork sandwiches, chips, coleslaw, macaroni and cheese donated by local businesses and council members are on the menu. Kristina will provide styrofoam cups, cream, sugar & sugar substitute for the coffee. Several local businesses in both counties have agreed to donate items for door prizes. This year we will separate prizes by county so it is more likely for gift certificates to be utilized. Kyle and Kristina will meet at the park the day before the picnic to arrange tables. Kyle will borrow tables from the church for food and bring them to the park. Bo has specifications from Foam Homies about set up and will meet Kristina at the park before the picnic to plan accordingly.

Recovery Month Activities: Kristina asked council members to assist with posting on social media during recovery month. Each Tuesday in September we plan to post a video testimonial to the Clark/Cumberland County ROSC page. We need to post daily the whole month of September. In addition, there will be an opportunity for persons in recovery to share a snippet about recovery on the radio. We will continue our Communication Campaign with a press release, signed proclamations from Mayors, and infographics.
