<u>Presentation By: Sherie Martinez representing (IPHI):</u>

Sherie Arriazola Martinez from the Illinois Public Health Institute (IPHI) provided a presentation on new funding opportunities under the Illinois Medical Respite Capacity Building Initiative. This initiative, which aligns with the state's plan to prevent and end homelessness, focuses on enhancing outcomes for individuals experiencing homelessness by integrating housing, healthcare, and social services. Since December 2022, IPHI has been managing the initiative, supporting 29 communities across Illinois with both funding and technical assistance. A new round of grants is opening this month. Grants are available for \$50,000, with the potential for up to \$100,000, aimed at helping new recipients plan for medical respite services, which provide temporary shelter and care for people recovering from illness, injury, or behavioral health issues. They want to bring awareness of these grants to southern Illinois. Additionally, recent federal approval under the state's 1115 Waiver allows Medicaid coverage for these services.
