
Special Guest: Robin Throneburg – DART

Robin Throneburg outlined the roles of deflection teams in Central Illinois, particularly DART's efforts in substance abuse treatment, mental health support, and housing assistance. She emphasized the program's proactive approach in connecting individuals with necessary resources, highlighting recent expansions to their team to better serve the community.

The discussion also covered the referral and engagement process for individuals seeking assistance, with Throneburg detailing the importance of accurate information and collaboration with law enforcement. She explained the voluntary nature of the program, allowing individuals to decline help if they wish. Robin also explained how law enforcement can help by providing information and emphasized the team's dedication to relentless engagement with participants, ensuring that they are contacted within 48 hours of a referral. The meeting further addressed the Treatment Alternatives for Safe Communities (TASC) program's role in deflection, distinguishing it from diversion, and the need for tailored support for participants.

<u>Council Meeting Discussion Topic:</u> Updates to McLean ROSC FY25 Communication & Outreach Plan

Cat Hays noted that we are focusing on refining our communication strategies for the outreach plan. We asked some questions and gathered via a slido pole.



The feedback indicated that email and Zoom were effective communication methods, while biweekly updates were preferred for frequency. The discussion aimed to streamline outreach efforts and target specific audiences.
