D. **Family Support-**Craig Loddeke-Chairperson:

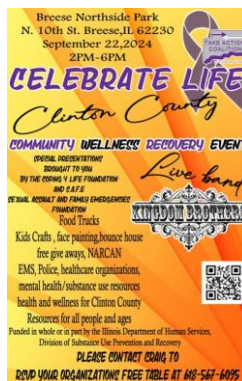
