    - Training on ROSC for providers
    - Identify providers who may work with at-risk populations

    - Peer support in person
    - ROSC 101 binder distribution

- Do ROSC 101 presentations to Probation staff
- Promote HMA/MAR Collaborative
- Continue interviewing probation clients
- Faith Communities:
  - Meetings in person
  - IL Faith & Recovery Collaborative
  - Schedule meetings with ministries
  - Identify champions within the church
  - Equipping church volunteers to be the point of contact
  - Identify existing support groups within faith communities
- PLE's and Families
  - Recovery In action- going into the community, building capacity
  - Invitation from peers
  - Local schools
  - Posters, flyers, etc. in high-risk areas
  - Town hall style meetings
  - Ask- is there anyone that you know who wants to help?
  - IHR support group
  - Outreach at events
  - Share testimonies- identify champion
- SUD/MH Providers
  - Public awareness
  - Yearly presentations for OSF providers
