Presentation:

Jacob Webb, Staff Sargeant works for the Illinois National Guard Counterdrug Task Force as an investigative support analyst. His purpose as an analyst with Marion PD is to assist their detectives with critical intel to combat the movement and distribution of narcotics throughout the city of Marion. He also acts as a liaison between the PD and other entities in order to provide a better understanding of what it is the other does and deals with on a daily basis. His role is primarily an advisory role where he can provide suggestions and constructive feedback on things.

He presented the seizure stats for the months of November and December along with the arrests that goes with that from the Marion PD.

Assistant Chief of Police also attended to provide guidance on policies and to help answer any questions.
