### Discussion

Katie Depew discussed some information about the gaps in service for mental health and the different struggles and barriers she has gathered while researching homelessness programs in different areas and how they could be helpful to our community. She discussed a new program for the community to send a licensed professional out to de-escalate situations for police departments. Carbondale already has started this and it seems to be working well. She stated that the City of Marion may be looking for licensed professionals soon. ## **Old Business**

Mandy went over the community survey results:

- 126 total responses but a majority of them were from other states.
- We had a total of 32 responses we could use.
- A majority of respondents were unaware of harm reduction services and MAR treatment
- A majority of respondents did not know what harm reduction or MAR even was.

Anthony Airington recommended using a new platform next year and getting paper copies into the jails, recovery housing, and recovery programs through utilizing those on the ROSC Council that work in those environments.

Mandy noted that we know the community needs to be educated on what Harm Reduction and MAR treatment is and we need to keep that in mind when planning upcoming events.

Last year FWRC partnered with TAT Harm Reduction program and hosted local "Pop-Up" events so that is something we will look into again this year among other events.

Aisha Esquivel is willing to help with providing MAR Education for FWRC.

Christina Manchen is willing to help with surveys or hosting focus groups in the future.

### **New Business**
