

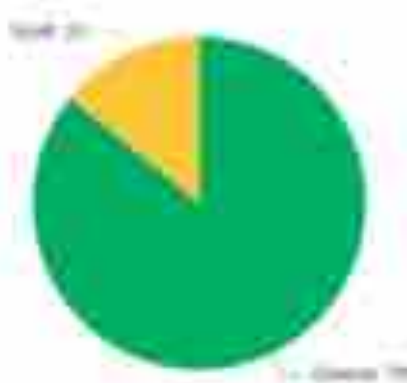

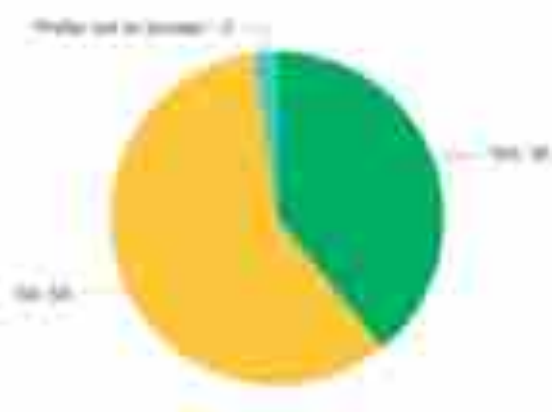

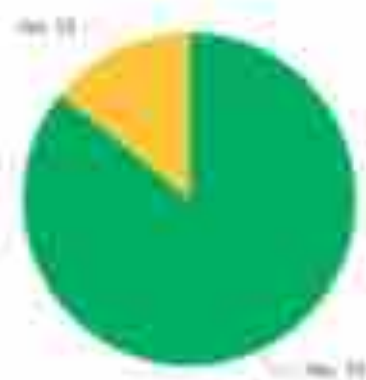

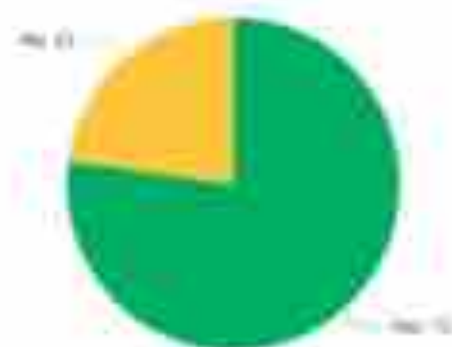

12: **Do you know how to access assistance for Family support services**

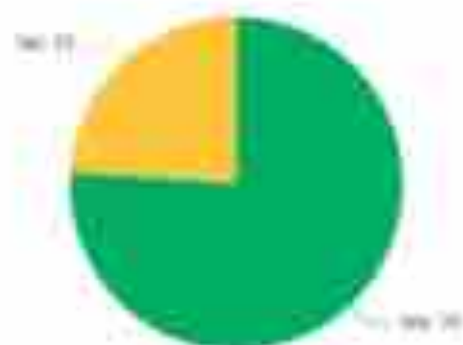

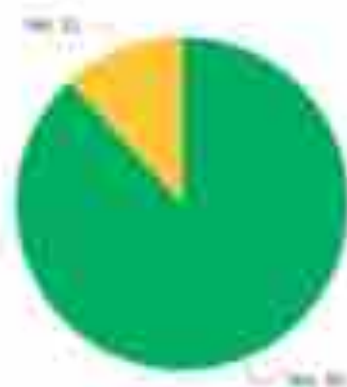

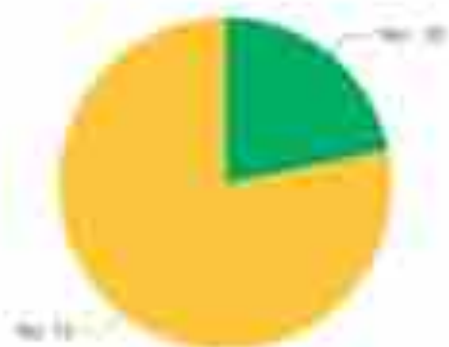

12: Would you like to get involved with the local ROSC Recovery Oriented Systems of Care Council? (Multiple Choice)



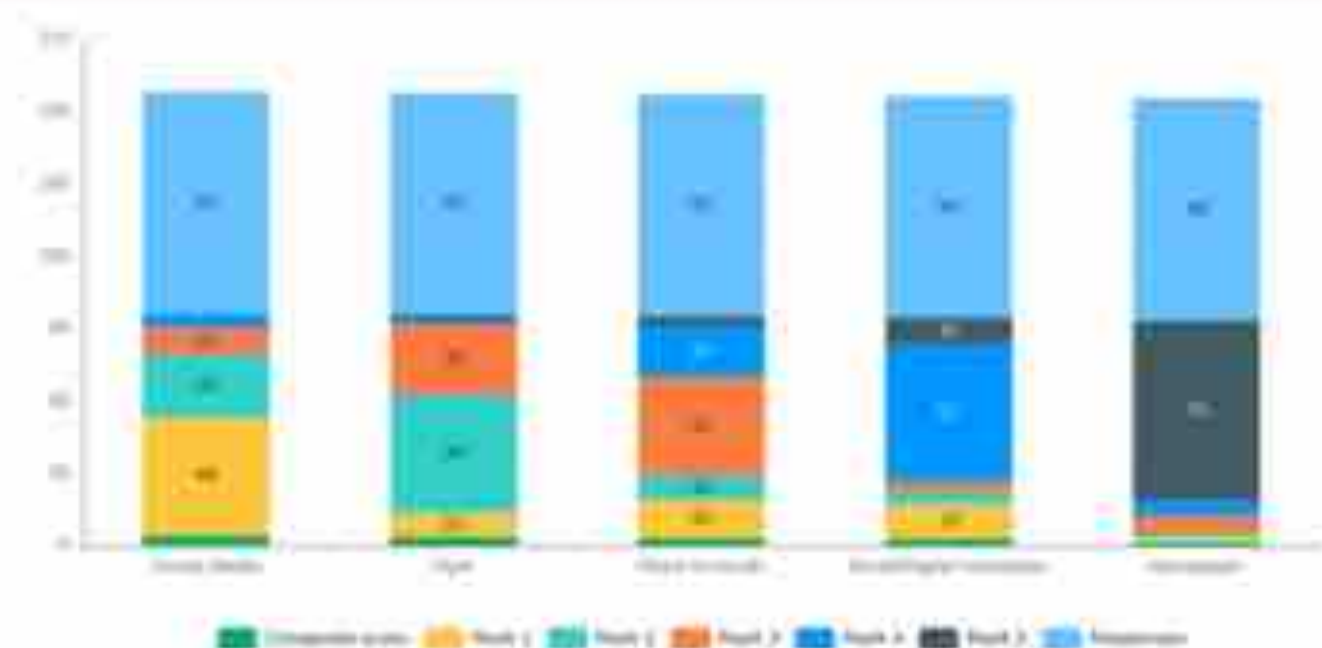

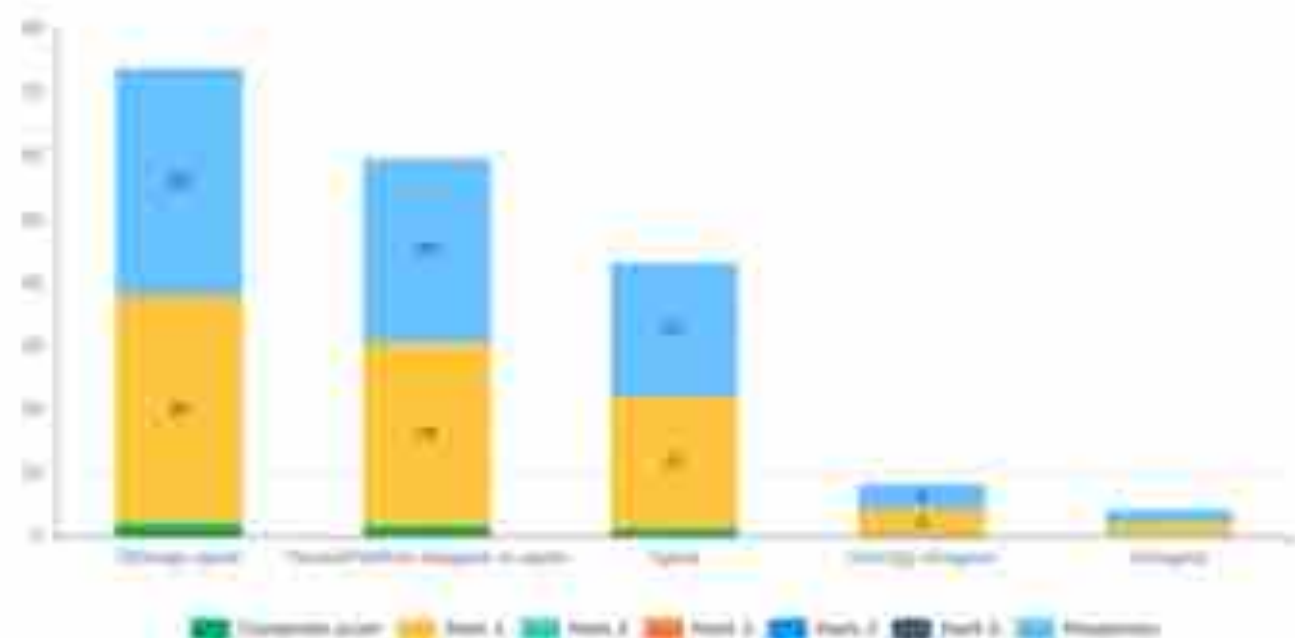


20: How do you prefer to receive information about county resources/events/services? (Total: 316)



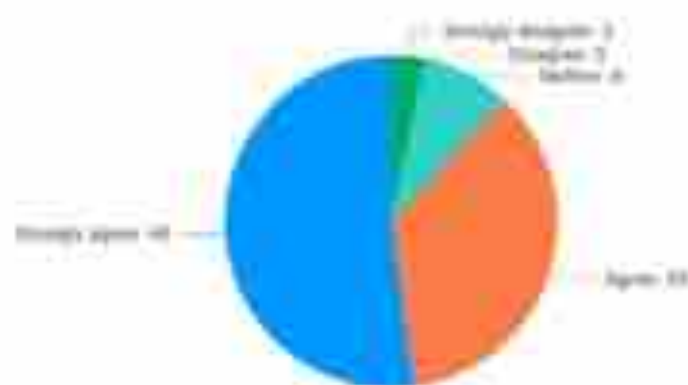

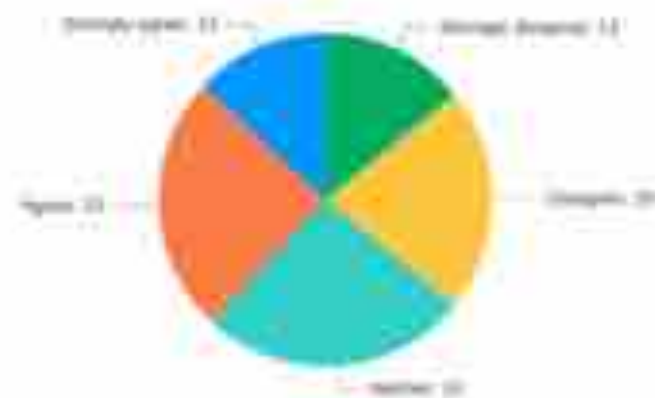

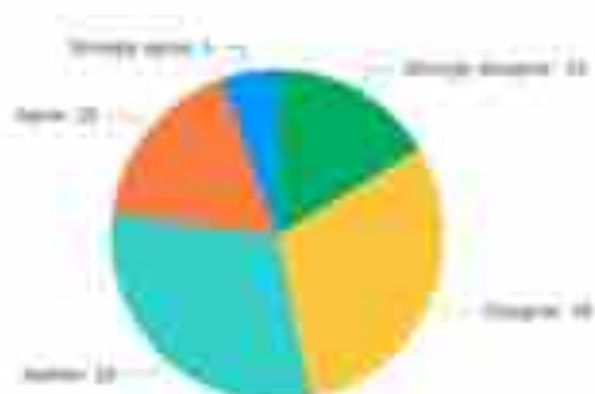

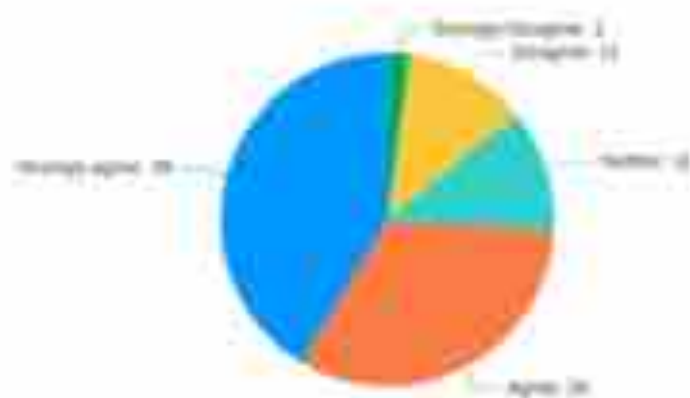

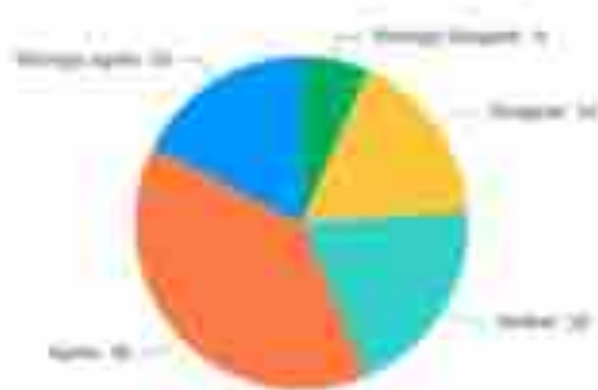

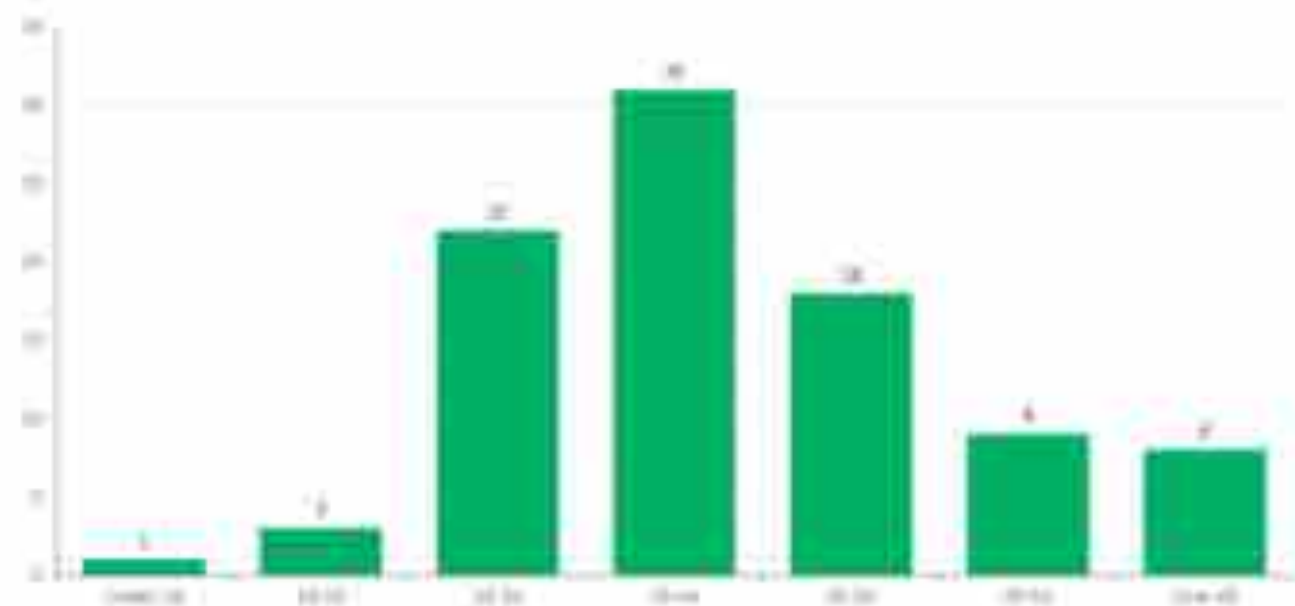

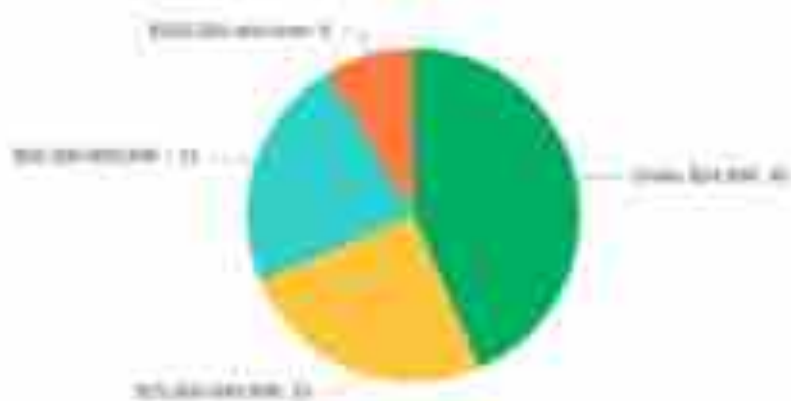

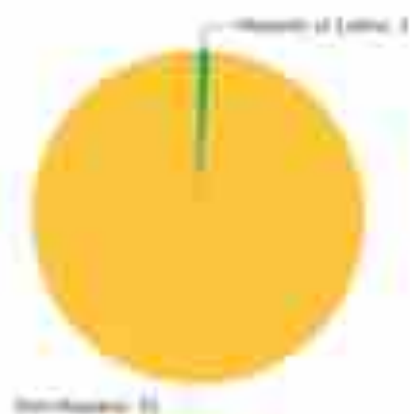

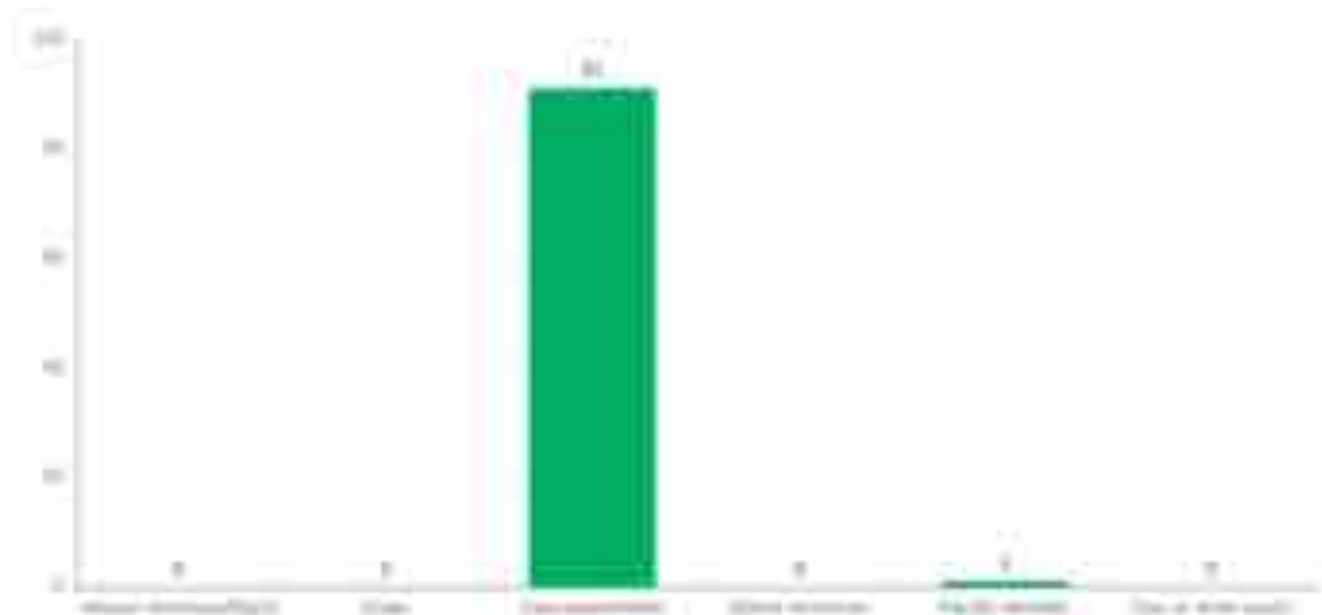

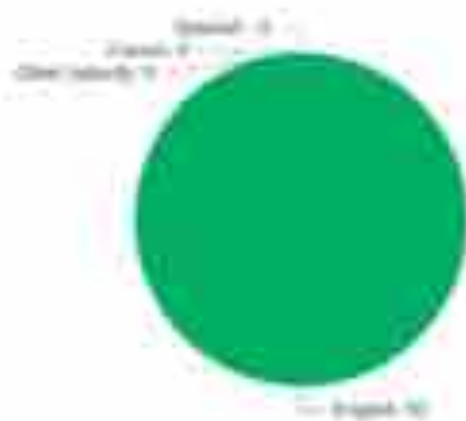
