Agenda Items and Discussion:

1. Welcome and Introductions:

- Bamani Obadeli welcomed everyone to the annual ROSC monthly meeting (Recovery Oriented Systems of Recovery).
- Participants introduced themselves and shared their current feeling on a scale of 1 to 10.
- Attendees were reminded to sign in via the chat, providing their name and organization.

2. Upcoming Events:

- o Bamani Obadeli inquired about upcoming events from organizations present.
- o An event from CPS partners was anticipated but they were not on the call.
- Bamani Obadeli announced a successful Narcan and fentanyl strip testing giveaway in the Fuller Park community, in partnership with a local business owner.

3. Presentation by Sylvester House Enterprises:

- Nygeria Slayden-Figgers introduced June Reed, the Executive Director of Sylvester House Enterprises.
- June Reed presented on her upcoming residential facility for single women, returning citizens, and survivors of sexual violence on the south side of Chicago (65th and Vernon), with a target opening date in June.

- The facility will offer stable housing and connect residents with resources for recovery, reentry, job readiness, mental health support, and eventual independent housing.
- June Reed shared her personal connection to substance use and her motivation for this work.
- o The program will be a mix of recovery-focused and reentry support.

4. Lawrence Hall - Hopes Program:

- Narestus S Coley MSW LSW of Lawrence Hall shared information about the Hopes program, which supports returning citizens (ages 16-99) with hospitality and culinary arts training.
- o The program is located at their South Shore location.
- o A flyer with contact information will be shared.

5. Grand Boulevard Prevention Services Updates:

- Laurel Taylor-Dudley highlighted upcoming summer events and potential youth work opportunities.
- She emphasized the role of the ROSC Council in bringing agencies together to support recovery and providing information on available services.
- o An invitation was extended to Lawrence Hall to become a member of the council.
- The importance of verifying the operational status of referred service providers was discussed.

6. Strategic Plan and Sober Events:

- Stacy Munroe discussed Goal 6 of the strategic plan: strengthening prevention and early intervention efforts.
- A key activity is to develop and implement sustainable, safe, and sober community events.
- They are also enhancing youth substance use prevention efforts, providing resources to parents and schools.
- Volunteers were requested to help with planning sober events, potentially starting in the fall. Interested individuals were asked to put their name in the chat or email Bamani Obadeli, Stacy Munroe, or Nygeria Slayden-Figgers.

7. Upcoming Announcements:

- Marvell Singletary announced a job fair hosted by Acclivus on Monday, May 12th, at 8350 South Cottage Grove (Discover Center), encouraging attendees to bring resumes, ID, and social security cards. A flyer will be shared.
- Edward Boone from West Side ROSC invited everyone to their May 23rd Zoom meeting at 10:00 AM, celebrating women in recovery and reentry. CEUs will be offered, and an invitation will be sent.
- o Kenneth Bell commended the recent ROSC for meeting and announced the next monthly meeting for all Cook County ROSC Councils on Tuesday, May 27th.
