

Needs Assessment Survey

The Opioid Training and Technical Assistance Center (OTTAC), led by Prevention First, is conducting a statewide anonymous survey to assess the training and technical assistance needs of healthcare and service providers addressing opioid use disorder (OUD) and co-occurring mental health conditions (COD). 


