Impact Report FY25







STIGMA REDUCTION

- 60+ local businesses supported anti-stigma efforts (billboards, events, donations, Narcan).
- 4 community events featured lived experience storytelling (Recovery Strikes, Together in Tune, Laundry Days, Candlelight Vigil).
- 1 countywide anti-stigma campaign: "We Can and Do Recover"
- Monthly awareness Campaigns: Education materials and peer meetings.

HARM REDUCTION AWARENESS

- 2,000+ boxes of Narcan and fentanyl test strips distributed.
- 70+ DOPP sites (Narcan distribution) active across Coles County updated monthly.
- 26 boxes of Narcan distributed at 1 Lake Land College training (14 attendees).
- Narcan/fentanyl education provided at 5+ major public events.

RECOVERY RESOURCE ACCESS

- 100+ Homeless Outreach Bags distributed via police, fire, shelters, and street outreach.
- 3 new peer-led meetings added this year (now 25 total: 17 AA, 6 NA, 1 All Recovery, 1 CR, 1 Al-Anon).
- Many Outreach events hosted: Laundry Days, Speak & Eat, Recovery Strikes, Together in Tune.
- 70+ sites offering recovery info alongside Narcan.
- 35+ families served through Laundry Days.
- All Resouces Guides and Newsletters updated monthly, shared on social media, GSU, & Printed.
- Events scheduled around Dial-A-Ride hours.
- Volunteer transportation list launched to support treatment access.

COMMUNITY & ROSC COUNCIL GROWTH

- 35+ new ROSC members added during events.
- Several new partnerships community Partnerships (Hope, Salvation Army, Lytle Park Board, etc.)
- 76 new social media followers.
- Sector Growth (LGBTQ+, BIPOC, Faith, Business, PLE, local Government)

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
