ABOUT THE PLAY:

Set around the Civil War, the daughter of a wealthy Jewish merchant helps a young African American woman escape slavery, sparking events that change their lives. In a nation divided by race, religion, and politics, Eleanor and Hanna face war, loss, and betrayal in their quest for freedom.

ABOUT THE PRODUCTION:

This is a workshop production in front of an audience in The Center for Performing Arts. All rehearsals will be held on the Governors State University campus.

Pay varies based on the role.

- \$500 stipend for lead roles*.
- \$250 for ensemble roles^.

This is a non-equity workshop production.

Bridget[^] (Caucasian woman of 18)

Finley[^] (Caucasian man 40 and 60)

Ensemble[^] (Caucasian and African American)

PREPARATION:

Auditionees are asked to either submit a self-tape or attend the in-person auditions, and <u>complete the audition form</u>.

Self-Tape: Auditioners will need to submit an audition self-tape that is no longer than 3 minutes in length and complete the *DIVIDED* audition form. Self tapes are to include the following:

- 16-32 bars of a standard musical song
- Monologue

All self-tapes are to be sent to Production Manager, Staci Corum at scorum@govst.edu by January 30, 2026 by 11:59pm.

Auditionees submitting self-tapes will be expected to attend callbacks.

In-Person Auditions: Auditionees should prepare 32 bars of a song in the style of musical theatre or pop, whatever best shows their voice and storytelling.

Callbacks: Auditionees should expect to cold read sides from the show and learn and perform about 23 bars of music from *DIVIDED*.
