Admission Requirements

- Have a GPA of 2.5 or higher on a 4.0 scale.
- The Bachelor of Health Administration (BHA) program follows a rolling admission process. Submitted materials are reviewed on an ongoing basis, with admissions occurring three times a year for the Fall, Spring, and Summer terms.

Degree Requirements

Students must meet all university requirements for a bachelor's degree.

All required courses and the upper-division selectives must be completed with a grade of "C" or better, and successful completion of 150 hours field experience.

In addition, all students must complete a pre-graduation survey. The Practicum placement is arranged by the Program administration. No previous experience in healthcare is required.
