

April Preyar JD is a Chicago native, criminal defense attorney, national television legal analyst, and grassroots legal educator. Preyar has been practicing law for 25 years. She graduated from Duke University and George Washington University Law School. She began her legal career at the Office of the Cook County Public Defender. Preyar left public service to begin her own practice, Preyar Law Offices. She later started a partnership, Shiller Preyar Law Offices, which spanned 12 years. She currently runs a solo practice, Preyar Legal Solutions. Preyar taught as an adjunct professor at Malcolm X College and John Marshall UIC Law School. She has served as a guest instructor at the University of Chicago Mandel Legal Clinic Fall Intensive Trial Advocacy Program. She also taught continuing legal education courses to fellow attorneys at the Chicago Bar Association. Preyar is the founder of JUSTUS JUNKIE, LLC, a legal educational company that uses videos to explain complex legal jargon in simple terms. She created the Trials & Triumph Board Game to teach teens how to interact with police safely while asserting their Constitutional rights and how to avoid the snares of the criminal courts. She launched Street Law Revolution, a 5-session curriculum based on the game. She recruited a team of skilled, knowledgeable attorneys to teach with her in schools and youth organizations. All are licensed, practicing criminal defense attorneys with at least 5 years of litigation experience. Preyar was voted "Best Lawyer of 2021" in the Chicago Reader. Preyar has appeared on international, national, and local television over 60 times in the last year as a subject matter expert on criminal law.
