Course Offerings and Info

Time: evenings (except field experiences)

Modality: online synchronous (at a scheduled time), online asynchronous, face-to-face (prereqs & field exp)

Field Experiences*: There are opportunities for job-embedded field experiences for the 4 clinical field experience courses and student teaching. Candidates may be eligible if the criteria for approved schools and for each course are met, as well as the requirements for job-embedded field experiences. Forms must be completed by the given date or candidates may not be able to do job-embedded field experiences.

Program Start: fall start only

Course Schedule: ECE program courses are only offered once a year.
