

Associate in Applied Science in Human Development and Family Studies to Bachelor of Health Science in Community Health

The following is presented as an articulation agreement between City Colleges of Chicago (CCC) and Governors State University (GovState) for the Community Health degree program based on the current catalogs of both schools. The student would receive an Associate in Applied Science (AAS) in Human Development and Family Studies degree from one of the CCC and a Bachelors of Health Science (BHS) degree in Community Health from GovState.
