

Associate of Arts to Bachelor of Arts in Anthropology & Sociology

The following is presented as an articulation agreement between City Colleges of Chicago (CCC) and Governors State University (GovState) for Anthropology and Sociology degree program based on the current catalogs of both schools. The student would receive an Associate of Arts (AA) degree from one of the CCC and Bachelors of Arts (BA) degree in Anthropology and Sociology from GovState.

I. TRANSFERABLE GENERAL EDUCATION CORE CURRICULUM: (38-39 Hours)

- SOC 201 - Intro to the Study of Society (3) (Meets SOC 1100)
- SOC 207 - The Sociology of Sex and Gender (3) (recommended; meet ANSO 2100 as GSU Selective)

II. ELECTIVES (23-24 Hours)

GSU's Anthropology-Sociology program suggests classes in any of the Social Sciences.

- SOC 241 - Institutional Racism (3) (recommended)

Selectives (18-21 Hours)

Students should select a minimum of 18 hours of upper-division courses from the approved list of selectives. A lower-division ANSO/ANTH/SOC course can count as a selective with advisor and program coordinator approval. Please meet with your program advisor for anticipated course offerings.

Electives (24-27 Hours)

Additional courses as approved by academic advisor to meet individual outcomes.
