

Associate in Arts with Basic Certificate in Community Health Worker to Bachelor of Health Science in Community Health

The following is presented as an articulation agreement between City Colleges of Chicago's (CCC) for the Community Health Worker certificate and Associate in Arts degree and Governors State University (GovState) for the Community Health degree program based on the current catalogs of both schools. The student would receive a certificate Community Health Worker and additional general education courses from one of the CCC and a Bachelors of Health Science (BHS) degree in Community Health with the concentration in Health Promotions across the Lifespan from GovState.
